SJM Presents 2024 IMG Academy Junior World Championships China Qualifier – Macau

Fostering the Next Generation of Golf Talent and enhancing Macau's stature of "City of Sports"

(Macau, 3 May 2024) Sponsored by SJM Resorts, S.A., the "2024 IMG Academy Junior World Championships China Qualifier – Macau" concluded successfully on 3 May at the Macau Golf and Country Club. This event is part of a series of qualifiers held across Greater China, with 3 May's event in Macau serving as the final round of selections. A total of 20 talented young golfers have been chosen to join 40 winners from earlier rounds to form the Chinese National Team. This team will compete in July at the "Junior World Championship Finals" in San Diego, USA, against top international players, representing our nation on a global stage.

SJM has a longstanding relationship with the golf community, maintaining close ties with international golf associations over the years. In 2023, SJM revitalised the "Macao Open," title sponsoring the tournament for three consecutive years and reintegrating Macau into the Asian Tour calendar.
