## SJM's Zuicho Earns First MICHELIN Star

Robuchon au Dôme and The Eight Receive Continued Recognition

(Macau, 13 March 2025) With SJM Resorts, S.A. ("SJM") serving as the venue supporter for the "MICHELIN Guide Ceremony Hong Kong Macau 2025," the ceremony was held at Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau today, unveiling the coveted list of awarded restaurants. SJM's dining outlets once again received remarkable achievements, with Grand Lisboa Palace's refined Japanese restaurant **Zuicho** debuting in the list, being recognised with one MICHELIN Star. Grand Lisboa Macau's **Robuchon au Dôme** and **The Eight** continue to earn three- and two- MICHELIN-Star ratings respectively, further solidifying the group's position at the summit of the fine dining scene.

"Zuicho's first MICHELIN Star marks an exciting new chapter for SJM's culinary landscape," shares Ms. Daisy Ho, Managing Director of SJM. "As Macau continues to shine as a UNESCO 'Creative City of Gastronomy,' we are deeply committed to celebrating the intersection of innovation and heritage, East and West. We will continue to push the boundaries of fine dining, offering unforgettable gastronomic experiences that honour Macau's status as a world-class dining destination."

Helmed by Executive Chef Yoshinori Kinomoto, Zuicho is an intimate homage to Japan's kappo tradition, which represents the most refined expression of Japanese haute cuisine. The restaurant's minimalist yet sophisticated design revolves around a ninemeter cypress counter, crafted from a 350-year-old tree, offering diners a front-row seat to an elegant, almost meditative, performance of knife work by the chefs while enjoying an exquisite omakase experience. Every ingredient is sourced with reverence, flown in directly from Japan to ensure an ever-evolving seasonal menu. The experience is further elevated with a curated collection of sake, whisky, and Japanese teas, each pairing thoughtfully chosen to complement the purity of flavours.

Since the guide's 2009 launch, the legendary Robuchon au Dôme at Grand Lisboa is the only dining establishment in Macau that has maintained its three-MICHELIN-Star rating for an impressive 17th consecutive year, while The Eight secured two Stars, celebrating 17 years of recognition.
