Established in 2023 by Ganlanhuabao and Spirits & Bartender magazine, the China's Cocktail and Spirits List Awards celebrate excellence in the bar industry across 60 Mainland China cities. Bar participate in a tiered system, advancing through levels based on consistent high performance. Awards are presented across five levels: Three-Star, Two-Star, One-Star, Must Drink and Quality Bars. Judges rigorously evaluate various factors, including menu design and bar concept alignment, consumer experience, the uniqueness and sustainability of the bar's offerings, drink quality and bartending technique, the use and transparency of base spirits and ingredients, and the overall consistency and innovation of the bar's creations. Winners are selected by a panel of experienced bartenders, spirits professionals and consumers, supported by anonymous site visits and comprehensive assessments.
