SJM Reaffirms Position as Asia's Leader in Wine Spectator's "Grand Award" Honours

Dominating Macau's Culinary and Wine Scene Alongside STDM with 11 Award-Winning Restaurants



Of just 97 top restaurants worldwide to receive this honour, two of Grand Lisboa Macau's iconic dining venues have once again earned their place among the best: Robuchon au Dôme continues its extraordinary streak with a 21st consecutive win, while Casa Don Alfonso celebrates its 16th consecutive year of recognition. In total, eleven restaurants of SJM and its parent company, Sociedade de Turismo e Diversões de Macau, S.A. ("STDM"), are honoured this year on the Macau list, continuing the record-breaking success from 2024.

In addition to the two flagship awardees, The Eight and The Kitchen at Grand Lisboa have each retained the "Best Award of Excellence." Over at Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau, six restaurants including Palace Garden, Mesa by José Avillez, Zuicho, Don Alfonso 1890, Hua Ting and The Grand Buffet, as well as Guincho a Galera at Hotel Lisboa Macau also received the same distinction, underscoring SJM and STDM's comprehensive strength in the fine dining arena.

Renowned for its rigorous selection criteria, Wine Spectator's "Grand Award" is reserved for restaurants with wine lists of at least 1,000 selections, including rare vintages, premier estates, and large-format bottles. The "Best Award of Excellence" requires more than 350 quality labels, alongside expert storage conditions and a knowledgeable service team.









