This special showcase offers spectators a fresh angle on the sport, blending professional athleticism with celebrity flair. A lucky draw was also held, offering attractive prizes to spectators.



During the match, Li Na shared on-court insights drawn from her Grand Slam experience; Coleman Wong demonstrated the speed and power of the new generation of professional players; while Wu Chun and Alex Lam showcased the enthusiasm and athleticism of non-professional tennis lovers, bringing an extra layer of interaction to the showcase. The cross-disciplinary pairings embodied the spirit of tennis — perseverance, learning and collective progress.
