**SJM Leads Asia
with the Highest Number of Wine Spectator Grand Awards**

***Unrivalled Depth of Wine Excellence and Gastronomy Reaffirms Macau's
Global Standing as a "Creative City of Gastronomy"***

(Macau, 24 June 2026) – SJM Resorts, S.A. (“SJM”) once again sets the benchmark for wine and dining excellence in Asia, achieving the region’s highest number of Wine Spectator “Grand Award” in 2026. Among the honours, Robuchon au Dôme and Casa Don Alfonso at Grand Lisboa Macau have each been awarded the prestigious Grand Award for the 22nd and 17th consecutive years, respectively. This year, a total of 18 restaurants (11 in Macau and 7 in Hong Kong) under SJM and its parent company, Sociedade de Turismo e Diversões de Macau, S.A. (“STDM”), were recognised in the Wine Spectator Restaurant Awards, representing the highest number of awarded establishments in Hong Kong and Macau.

In addition, STDM’s L’Atelier de Joël Robuchon Hong Kong, operated by Lisboa Food & Wines Ltd (Hong Kong), has also secured a coveted Grand Award, marking its 17th consecutive year receiving this prestigious distinction. Together with SJM’s two awarded restaurants, the Group holds three of the five Grand Awards presented in Asia, underscoring its leading strength in wine curation and culinary innovation.

Beyond the three Grand Award recipients, SJM’s The Eight and The Kitchen at Grand Lisboa Macau, alongside Palace Garden, Mesa by José Avillez, Zuicho, Don Alfonso 1890, Hua Ting, The Grand Buffet at Grand Lisboa Palace Resort Macau; as well as STDM’s Guincho a Galera at Hotel Lisboa Macau have once again achieved the “Best Award of Excellence.” Together, these honours reflect SJM’s breadth of offerings—from Michelin-starred fine dining to contemporary culinary destinations—each supported by world-class wine programmes that elevate the overall guest journey.

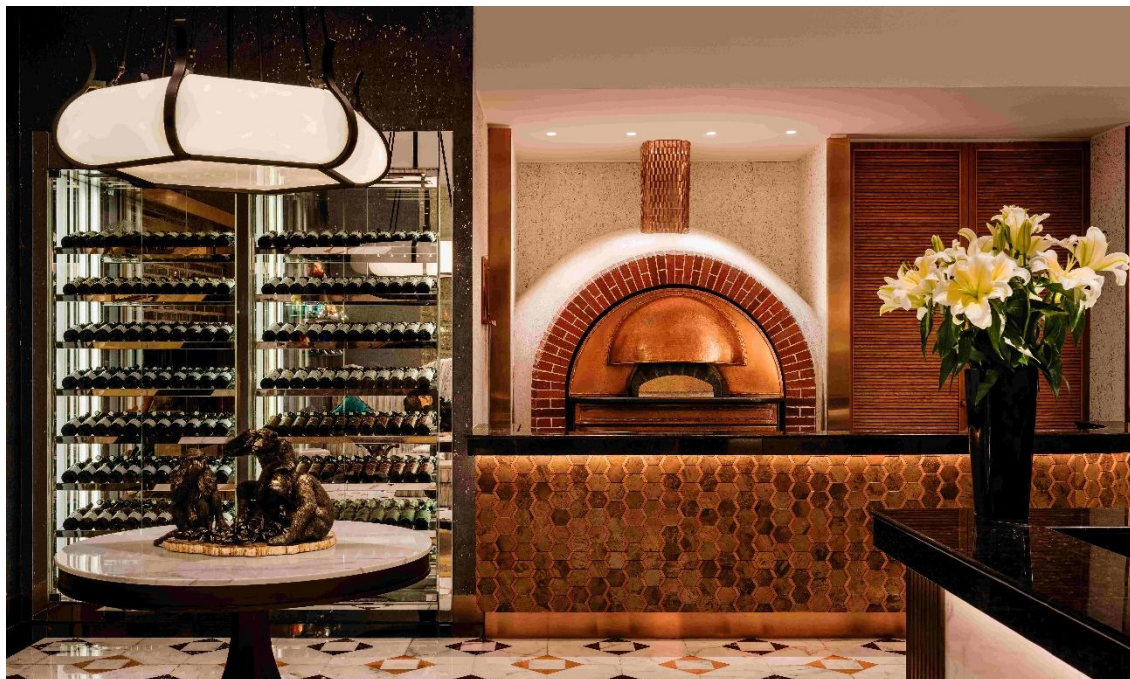
Globally Recognised Benchmark in Wine Excellence
